5. **Curriculum Development:** The insights gained from the workshop empowered teachers to contribute to curriculum development by incorporating ICT-based teaching methodologies.

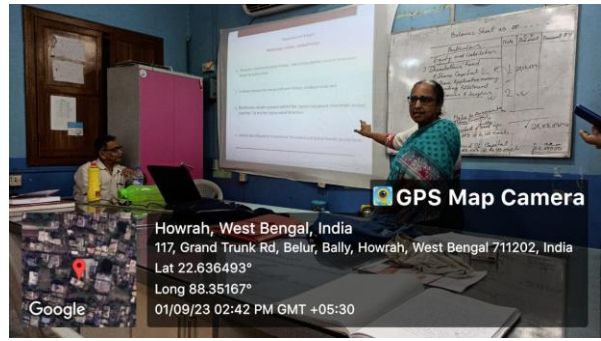

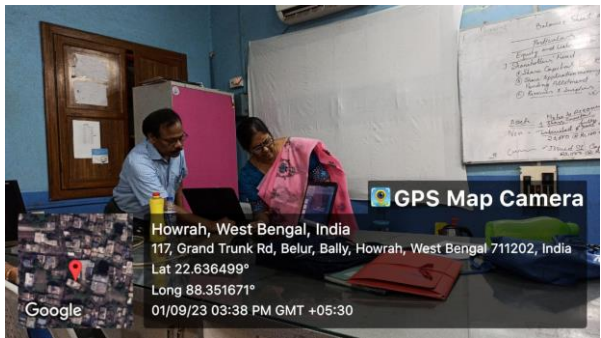
GPS Map Camera



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
