(2022-23)**


The *Lalbaba College Grievance Redressal Committee* (LBCGRC) was established on 29<sup>th</sup> September, 2021. Four (4) meetings of this committee were held during the academic session 2022-23. These meetings discussed about the implementation of effective mechanism for online grievance application along with offline submission of grievance application form. M/S Right Brains Technology, who is already responsible for College ERP, was entrusted for preparing the online modules towards redressal of student grievances, if any. Software for on-line mechanism regarding application of grievances through the college website is already developed.

The IQAC of Lalbaba College conducted an Administrative Training Programme on Information Management System (IMS) which aims to review the software. The software is prepared on the basis of the fallacy that if student seeking information from college office and is rejected and/or unsatisfied, only then the grievance on the issue is generated. It is also stated that Information Management is highly important for the mechanism of grievance redressal system. A separate grievance application mechanism also designed for direct application of grievances.

Students are recommended to lodge complaints in on-line/offline mode without any hesitations on the following purposes:-

- (i) Admission (Student enrolment, Fee Payment, Document verification),
- (ii) University Registration (Form submission, Fee Payment, Registration Certificate),

The LBCGRC unanimously decided that the grievance redressal mechanism will start effectively from the academic session (2023–24) through **online** and **offline** mode simultaneously and at least three "Grievance Boxes" will be placed in the position nearest to college office, Library and Teachers' room along with three boards for displaying major points relating to Grievance redressal.

The Grievance Redressal Committee aims to look into the complaints lodged by any student and resolve it as per requirement on the basis of the prevailing law/rule/regulation/statute. Students can state their grievance relating to any academic and administrative matter within the campus through 'Information/grievance Application Form' (online/offline) which will be available in the office counter, Library and Teachers' room of the college. The institution aims to resolve all the grievances of the students within stipulated time.
