 - 4.3. pronouns in masculine, feminine and neuter genders shall be construed to include any other gender;
 - 4.4. headings are for convenience only and shall not be interpreted to limit or otherwise affect the provisions of this Memorandum of Understanding.

5: Background

- 5.1. RICE is a Company engaged in providing preparatory courses for various competitive examinations conducted by the State and the Central Government;
- 5.2. COLLEGE is an institution of Higher Studies providing Degrees, Post Graduate Degrees and Diplomas in various streams.
- 5.3. The parties appreciate that specialised trainings are required to compete in various examinations conducted by Government Agencies;
- 5.4. The Parties hereto have decided to associate themselves for the benefits of the students of the COLLEGE through its **Cell for Competitive Examinations and Career Guidance (CCECG)** to create awareness amongst the students regarding various competitive examinations.

6. Obligations of RICE:

- 6.2. Provide One- On - One Career Counselling session to interested College students/ Alumni
- 6.3. Share details of various jobs in the Government sector with College Placement Cell
- 6.4. Conduct Demo Classes for the interested College students/ Alumni, preferably twice a year
- 6.5. Conduct RICE Merit Scholarship Test, preferably once a year, to offer to the deserving candidates special fees structure on the various Offline Courses
- 6.6. Conduct free Mock Interview sessions for College students/ Alumni periodically.
- 6.7. Conduct free Sample Mock Test sessions for College students/ Alumni periodically
- 6.8. Conduct Special Motivation Classes from the successful students of RICE periodically.
- 6.9. Share success stories in future with the college placement cell if any
- 6.10. Issue of Certificate/e_Certificate to the candidates after completion of each program which will sign jointly by the Head of "the parties".
- 6.11. Prepare Activity Report after completion of each program.
- 6.12. Submit Annual Report after completion of every academic session (July to June).

7. Obligations of COLLEGE:

- 7.1. Extend co-operation to conduct the above programs on mutually convenient date and time through its **Cell for Competitive Examinations and Career Guidance (CCECG)**;
- 7.2. Ensure adequate participation of its students/ Alumni in the above programs;
